QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- Be 17 years or older (by start of program—June 3, 2019)
- Be enrolled and in good standing at four-year college or university
- Be a U.S. citizen, or U.S. national or lawful permanent resident of the United States

HOURS, BENEFITS, AND COMPENSATION:

As quarter-time AmeriCorps members, Teaching Fellows are required to accumulate 450 hours within the service period of **June 3-August 2, 2019** (approximately 50 hours/week) in order to receive the following:

- Living Stipend (\$2,000)
- CNCS Education Award (\$1,566)- upon completion of **450 service hours**
- Affordable housing options available
- Non-monetary benefits (on-going support, professional development)
