Breakthrough Central Texas Celebrates College Completion for 80 First-Generation Graduates

WHAT: Breakthrough Central Texas GradFest

On Saturday, June 1, 2024, Breakthrough Central Texas will host Grad Fest, the organization's annual intimate gathering celebrating Breakthrough Central Texas students who have graduated from college, university or a certificate program within the past year. This year, Breakthrough celebrates 87 college graduates, and the milestone of supporting 353 students through postsecondary success since 2002.

During GradFest, students and families will hear from the Class of 2024 Breakthrough Alumnus and St. Edward's University graduate Ricky LeFranc, executive director Michael Griffith, and Breakthrough College & Career Success staff who will guide them on their next steps. The celebration includes an open mic opportunity for students to reflect on their 12-year experience as Breakthrough students and culminates with the Breakthrough Alumni Network's presentation of academic stoles to the growing community of first-generation graduates.

Breakthrough Central Texas students persist at more than 100 colleges and universities around the country, and to-date have graduated from 82 unique institutions and certificate programs. In 2024, the organization will serve more than 3,400 students in Central Texas, ranging from entering sixth graders to college seniors.
