


BREAKTHROUGH IS THE LEADING COLLEGE ACCESS AND SUCCESS NONPROFIT IN CENTRAL TEXAS.




ABOUT OUR STUDENTS

Breakthrough students attend 60+ public schools and persist at nearly 100 colleges and universities.

Nearly 60% of Breakthrough students graduate from college, compared to 15% of low-income students in our region.

Our work has resulted in more than 350 college graduates, with more than 3,400 on their way, positively impacting families for generations, our region's educational equity, and the Central Texas economy.

12-YEAR PROGRAM

We make a radical, long-term commitment to partner with students, families, and communities for up to 12 years, beginning as early as 6th grade.

SCHOOLWIDE PROGRAM

We partner with targeted public high schools to transform them into best-in-class college access institutions serving every junior and senior on campus.

POLICY ADVOCACY

Through our advocacy efforts, we elevate the voices and experiences of our students and families to champion policies that advance educational equity for all students at the local, state, and federal level.

WE SUPPORT THE WHOLE STUDENT

We combine comprehensive, individualized advising with academic learning, career preparation, and leadership development – from middle school summer programs to college internships. Breakthrough provides high-quality postsecondary counseling to guide students to apply to, afford, and persist in their chosen path (bachelor, associate, or certificate). Supporting the whole student also means helping them overcome non-academic obstacles, including direct assistance for unexpected financial hurdles, mental health services, and basic needs.

WE GET REAL RESULTS

At every grade level, our students outpace their peers on critical milestones, including school attendance, grades, test scores, and college entrance exams.



96% graduate from high school on time, compared to 83% of students from low-income communities.



82% enroll directly in a four-year, two-year or certificate program, compared to 35% of students from low-income communities.



Nearly 60% graduate with a diploma or certificate, compared to 15% of high school students from lowincome communities.
